Description The division of oral pathology and oral medicine combines two

specialty of oral medicine. Oral pathology sometimes referred to as oral and maxillofacial pathology is concerned with laboratory diagnosis and study of the causes and effects of diseases affecting the oral and maxillofacial regions (i.e. the mouth, the jaws and the face). Oral pathologists study tissue specimens to render an original diagnosis or offer second opinion. Oral medicine, on the other hand, is concerned with clinical diagnosis and non-surgical management of non-dental pathologies affecting

salivary gland diseases including Sjogren's syndrome.
